IS THE REPEATER IN USE? IS THE REPEATER IN USE?

Calling all ARES members to the Northwest Georgia District Amateur Radio Emergency Service Net

This is *your call sign*, *your call sign phonetically* my name is *your name* and I'm located in *your county*. I am the Net Control Station tonight for the NW GA District ARES Net. At this time would our Alternate Net Control for tonight please check-in.

[Wait, Acknowledge]

This net meets each Tuesday at 8 PM local time. This is a training and preparedness net. All Amateurs are welcome to check-in.

If you would like to check into the net. We ask that you register at w4hhh.org/ares. **This will add you to the Roll Call.** When the Roll is called. You should confirm your check-in with Net Control by giving your **Call, Name, and County.**

You may check into the net using one of the following linked repeaters.

KC4AQS 146.805 - Tone 100 Hz Jasper
W4GTA 145.350 - Tone 100 Hz Lookout Mountain
W4ABZ 146.715 - Tone 67 Hz Ringgold
WX4PCA 146.955 – Tone 77 Hz Dallas

You may also use the W4EDP-R or -L Echolink Nodes to check-in.

In the event that the 146.805 repeater is unavailable the net will move to the 146.700- with a tone of 123. This net may move to the 146.595 simplex frequency if needed.

When checking-in or making announcements or comments. Please allow the repeater to drop. Then wait another 2 seconds so that all linked repeaters can reset.

Are there any announcements for the net that are ARES related. Call Net Control to be recognized.

I'll now proceed with the roll call of the net. I ask you do not break the roll call except in the event of an emergency.

After roll call a training session will be conducted. The Net ask that you stay and be a part of the training.
